To consolidate the remarkable and visible achievements recorded so far by his administration in the health sector, Abia State Governor, His Excellency Dr. Alex Otti OFR, on Monday 20th January, flagged off the Renovation and Remodeling of 200 Primary Healthcare Centers in 100 days across 184 wards of Abia State, tagged “*Project Ekwueme*”.

As a Government deeply rooted in accountability and transparency, the Government deems it very necessary to publish the names and locations of these first sets of the 200 health centers undergoing renovation and retrofitting out of the 948 of them across the 184 Wards of the State.

In this publication, you will see the names, locations, and pictures of these health centers before the intervention of the Administration of Governor Otti. On completion, within 100 days, as the Governor has mandated, the new look of the primary health centers would also be published to keep the people properly informed. It is important to note that some of the health centers have reached more than 50% completion stage as work is speedily progressing to meet up with the deadline.

From the commissioner’s desk, you will see the summary of what Governor Otti intends to achieve through “*Project Ekwueme*” and his audacious, intentional, and strategic plans for the health sector of the State aimed at achieving universal health coverage and healthcare equity in Abia State.

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PROJECT EKWUEME

RENOVATING AND REMODELING 200 PRIMARY HEALTHCARE CENTERS IN 100 DAYS ACROSS 184 WARDS OF ABIA STATE

INTRODUCTION: At the inception of the tenure of the His Excellency, The Executive Governor of Abia State, Dr Alex Otti, OFR, in May 2023, he declared a state of emergency on the comatose Health sector setting off a carefully planned and implemented sequence of interventions aimed first at reviving the sector in the short term followed by audacious projects aimed at rejuvenating in the intermediate and long term so as to reposition the health sector in Abia state to serve as a model subnational health ecosystem for our country in terms of qualitative service delivery, modernized health system and infrastructure as well as Universal health coverage.

The dimensions of Dr Alex Otti's intentional transformative steps comprehensively address all levels of health care from Primary Healthcare, Secondary level care to Tertiary healthcare. Connecting health facilities at these care levels using digital health information management technology to create a functionally responsive referral system and drive access and uptake of health services through a robust health insurance plan is an overarching component of this plan so as to achieve universal health coverage and healthcare equity in Abia State.



Following the early resuscitative measures, which included prompt retrofitting of the Hospitals Amachara General hospital and Abia Specialist Hospital as well as the Abia State university Teaching Hospital to enable them to offer nonexistent specialized healthcare services and stem the tide of

preventable deaths from treatable health conditions, the government of Abia State under Dr Alex Otti unveiled a comprehensive blueprint for the rejuvenation of the healthcare sector. This multipronged strategy includes the following:

1. Remodeling and functionalization of the Primary Healthcare centers (PHC), starting with at least 1 PHC in 184 wards in Abia state.

2. Phased Remodeling and functionalization of General Hospital (GH)...One (1) GH in each Local Government area.

3. Remodeling of Tertiary Hospitals-Abia State University Teaching Hospital Aba and Abia Specialist Hospital (ASH) and ASH annex Amachara.

4. Establishment of a Quaternary Level Healthcare Facility ...The Abia Medical City to serve as the apogee medical referral center in our state and sub-continent. This center will be equipped with the capacity to offer first rate medical care using cutting-edge medical technology and skill sets available anywhere in the modern world.

Our current focus...the Remodeling of 200 PHCs occupies the root of all our interventions in the health sector. Primary Health care is therefore the first point of access to affordable healthcare by the populace. It remains the pivot for achieving health for all through Universal Health Coverage which addresses the core objective of SDG -3. According to the World Health

Organization and from various studies, around 90% of healthcare problems can be managed at the primary healthcare level, encompassing most essential interventions and preventative care for individuals and communities. These include maternal, child and neonatal healthcare services, immunization, malaria and infectious disease control, prevention, early detection and care of non-communicable diseases care, treatment of minor injuries etc.

On Monday 20th January 2025, at Ngwu PHC, Uzuakoli, HE, Dr Alex Otti, OFR the Executive Governor of Abia flagged-off project Ekwueme to the admiration of multitudes of Abians, who trooped out en-masse to witness the making of history.

By rebuilding and functionalizing primary health care centers in every ward, Dr Alex Otti brings healthcare to the door post of Ndi Abia, wiping away decades of misery.

The remodeling project began at the sites in early December 2024 and has a life cycle of 100 days from inception to completion. Currently, over half of them are beyond 50% completion, while a few of them are almost ready for commissioning across the state. Project Ekwueme is marked by mandatory quality specifications from the Ministry of Health for the PHCs in line with the WHO standards. For each of the three senatorial districts, there is a project coordinator appointed to oversee activities. The contractors handling the project are drawn from local communities further enhancing the

participation are supervised by the project consultant who works with the coordinators to deliver the specifications.

Of the 948 primary care centers, 749 represent active PHCs, while the remainder are immunization centers. With Project Ekwueme, the government of Abia has embarked on a journey of revitalizing healthcare delivery in the grassroots. Each of the primary health care centers will be equipped with modern facilities, water supply, solar power and accommodation for staff. The PHCs will be connected using digital technology to a zonal information hub in a general hospital as well as a central communication hub at the Abia state specialist hospital Umuahia. The digital health information linkage will help to track activities in the PHCs as well as monitor uptake of care services, staff activities, drug and vaccine distribution and utilization, health outcomes and security challenges and will have a central dashboard in the office of the commissioner for Health for continuous real time monitoring. Telehealth interventions and consultations will be delivered and capacity building activities offered to staff from remote locations by our local and international experts. The Government has announced that after the first phase , another 200 PHCs will be remodeled in a phase 2 of this project until all PHCs in Abia are revitalized.

To further drive community engagement and uptake, the state government is currently piloting a community health ownership project known as Abia State Community Health Ownership Teams

(Abia SCHOT). This community oversight team represents a community level task force for supervising PHC utilization, service delivery activities, security and an extra channel of reporting and evaluation of PHCs by the Ministry of Health.

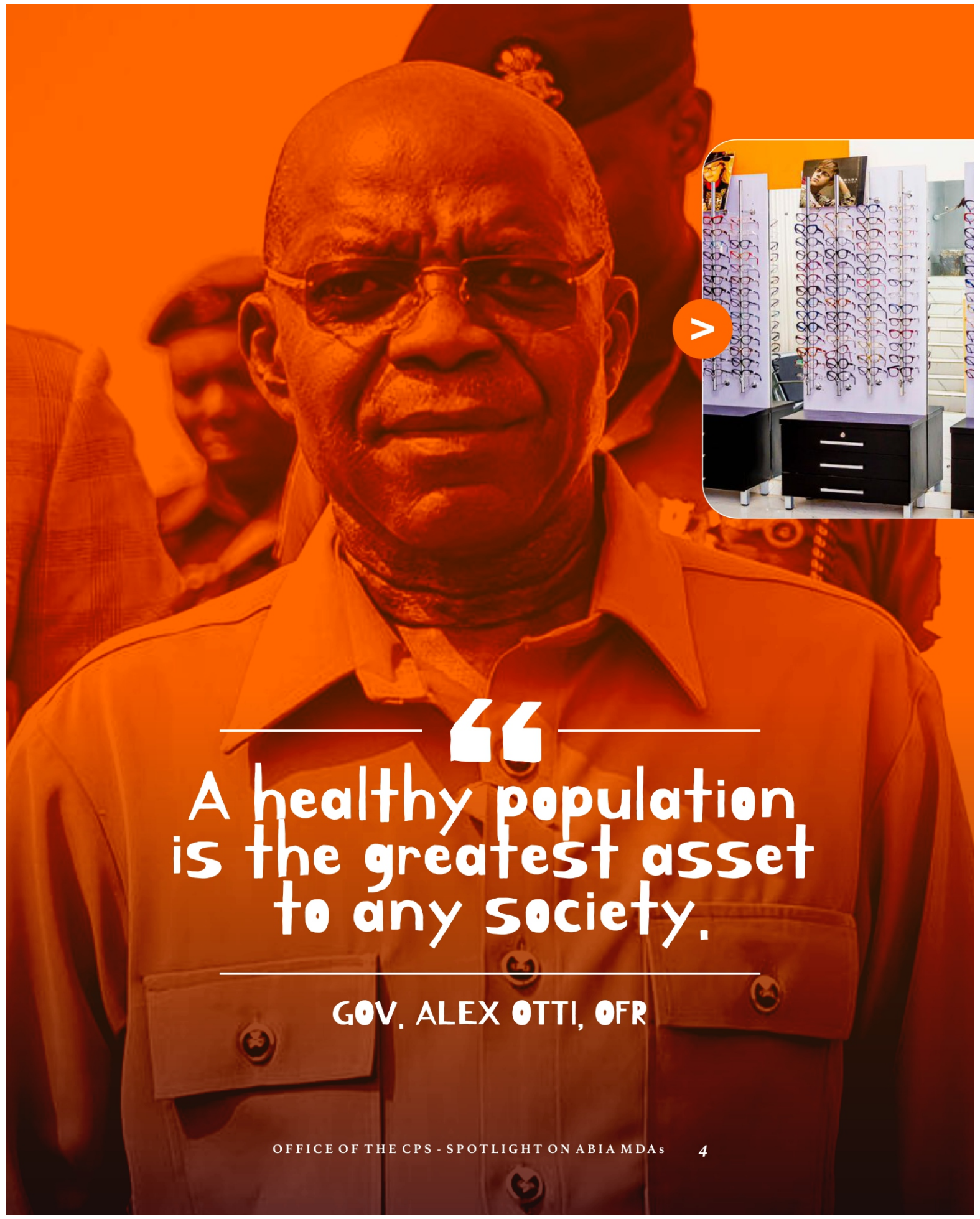
The cost of the first phase of the Primary Health Care remodeling is N10,784,805,066.70. This huge investment speaks to the unwavering commitment of a visionary leader towards improving the healthcare profile of his people not in rhetoric but in practical verifiable terms. Abia citizens are hereby enjoined to continue to support the result focused government of His Excellency, Dr Alex Chioma Otti, OFR, the Executive Governor of Abia state.

In the words of VI Lenin, ‘There are decades where nothing happens; and there are weeks where decades happen.’ In the few months of Dr Alex Ottis’ government, decades of neglect of the health sector in Abia are being rapidly replaced with **visible and verifiable progress, joy and a sustainable path to a healthier future.** The PHC locations involved in this first phase are hereby listed below for public information.

Professor Enoch Ogbonnaya Uche is a world renowned Neurosurgeon with over 25 years experience in Medical practice, mentorship and leadership. He graduated in the top 1% of his class from the prestigious University of Nigeria Medical School in 1998 with Distinctions in Anatomy, Pharmacology and Community Medicine. He completed residency in Brain and Spinal Neurosurgery at the University College Hospital in 2009 winning the award of best staff of the Neurological Surgery Department. He thereafter obtained Fellowship in Cerebrovascular and Skull base Surgery from the Arkansas Neuroscience Institute AR, USA. He became an alumnus of the world famous Harvard Post graduate Medical School after graduating from the Global Clinical Scholars Program.

He was appointed lecturer in Neurosurgery at the University of Nigeria, Nsukka in 2009 and rose to a full professor of Neurosurgery in 2019, becoming the first alumnus of UNN to be appointed Professor of Neurosurgery in the Institution and the first Abia citizen to obtain an academic chair in Neurosurgery in Nigeria. He is the 198th Inaugural Lecturer of the University of Nigeria.

Professor Enoch Ogbonnaya Uche is the current Commissioner for Health in Abia State. The Ministry of Health is charged with the responsibility of ; promoting and protecting the health and well being of Ndi Abia through the provision and regulation of health systems, facilities and services; disease surveillance, prevention and treatment; establishment and implementation of Health policies, standards and guidelines; ensuring optimal Human resource for health; regulation of drug distribution and use, Health care planning and outcome monitoring; Community engagement, research and capacity development.

He was previously Head of Neurosurgery, University of Nigeria, Member of Senate, University of Nigeria, Member of Governing Council , West African College of Surgeons, Cofounder and member of Governing Board of the Swedish African

Neurosurgery Collaboration(SANC), member of Governing Council , International College of Surgeons, Nigerian National Section, Member Editorial Board of the World Federation of Neurosurgical Societies flagship journal. He has over 100 academic publications in renowned international journals. He is an honored guest speaker at many international academic meetings and represents Neurosurgery at the Board of Surgery, West African College of Surgeons. He has served in many accreditation panels to Universities and Teaching Hospitals across West Africa. He has served as examiner to many medical schools as well as the West African college of surgeons. He serves as a reviewer to many high impact surgery, global health and neurosurgery journals. He has been appointed severally as assessor to academic chair promotions by highly reputable global universities.

His innovations in Neurosurgery include: the INTIMA model of Global Neurosurgery, NESCAPE paradigm, the LPDM model of collaborative neurosurgical education and ASAFRIN Brain Tumor model. He has trained and mentored over 20 neurosurgeons. A revered expert in endoscopic brain surgery, skull base surgery and global neurosurgery, his works in neurosurgery attracted grant funding from SANC and Neurokids USA as well as many collaborations from Europe and United States including revered scholars from the Boston Children's Hospital, Harvard Medical School. His global surgery research focuses on adaptation of innovative public health strategies to resolve inequities in neurosurgical care access , quality and training in the developing world. He led many free International Medical missions which rejuvenated or birthed neurosurgical care and training in many hospital locations including Nigeria, Liberia, Sierra Leone and the Gambia.
